Ireland: May 12 -18, 2019

Adare Manor

Sunday, May 12 - County Limerick

Arrive at Shannon Airport from US.

Saturday, May 18 - Edinburgh

Morning: Presentation. Drive to St Andrew's. Mass, lunch and sightseeing: ruins of the Norman Cathedral (or St Andrew's Cathedral); St. Andrew's Castle; optional round of golf at St Andrew's Golf Course.
