### **Catholic Education: Creating a Harvest of Vocations**

**Rhonda Gruenewald** | President/Founder, Vocation Ministry

Year after year, studies find that close to 75% of the newly ordained first considered being a priest between birth and 18 years of age, which emphasizes the absolute necessity to encourage vocations early in life.
