MONDAY, APRIL 15TH | WESTMINSTER | MODERATE WALKING

RETURN TO THE HOTEL FOR A BREAK AND THEN ENJOY SOME FREE TIME FOR PERSONAL ACTIVITIES. THE DAY CONCLUDES WITH A DELIGHTFUL DINNER

TUESDAY, APRIL 16TH | WESTMINSTER | MILD WALKING

WE WILL BEGIN THE DAY WITH A VISIT TO **ST. ETHELDREDA'S**, THE OLDEST CATHOLIC CHURCH IN ENGLAND, AND EXPLORE THE SHRINE TO ST. ETHELDREDA. NEXT, WE'LL HEAD TO **WESTMINSTER ABBEY**, WHERE WE WILL VENERATE THE SITE WHERE ST. EDWARD THE CONFESSOR IS BURIED.

FOLLOWING THE VISIT TO WESTMINSTER ABBEY, WE PLAN TO HAVE A PRIVATE TOUR OF **PARLIAMENT** TO LEARN ABOUT THE WORKINGS OF THE UK'S POLITICAL INSTITUTIONS. AFTER THE TOUR, WE WILL ENJOY A LEISURELY LUNCH. IN THE AFTERNOON, WE WILL HEAD TO **BUCKINGHAM PALACE** FOR A GUIDED TOUR OF THE ICONIC RESIDENCE OF THE BRITISH MONARCHY. THEN, WE WILL RETURN TO THE HOTEL FOR A BRIEF REST.

IN THE EVENING, WE WILL SAVOR A DELIGHTFUL DINNER TO CONCLUDE THE DAY.

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 17TH | ARUNDEL | MILD WALKING

AS THE DAY DRAWS TO A CLOSE, WE WILL MAKE OUR WAY BACK TO LONDON. THE DAY CONCLUDES WITH A DELIGHTFUL DINNER SERVED AT THE HOTEL, ALLOWING YOU TO REFLECT ON THE DAY'S MEMORABLE EXPERIENCES.

THURSDAY, APRIL 18TH | CITY OF LONDON | MODERATE WALKING

WE WILL HAVE A LEISURELY LUNCH BREAK.

IN THE AFTERNOON, WE WILL VISIT THE **MONUMENT TO THE GREAT FIRE OF LONDON**, FOLLOWED BY A STOP AT **ST. PAUL'S CATHEDRAL**, AN ANGLICAN MASTERPIECE. THE DAY WINDS DOWN WITH FREE TIME FOR PERSONAL ACTIVITIES, CONCLUDING WITH A PLEASANT DINNER.

FRIDAY, APRIL 19TH | CITY OF LONDON | MODERATE WALKING

OUR SECOND DAY IN LONDON BEGINS WITH A MORNING MASS. THE HIGHLIGHT OF THE MORNING IS A SCENIC BOAT RIDE DOWN THE RIVER, WHICH WILL TAKE US TO BOTH **HAMPTON COURT** AND **RICHMOND**, OFFERING BREATHTAKING VIEWS AND A LEISURELY JOURNEY.
